

**City Population Estimates  
Southeast Missouri Region  
July 1, 2000 to July 1, 2004**

On June 30, 2005 the Census Bureau released July 1, 2004 population estimates for incorporated places and minor civil divisions in the State of Missouri. The following table covers the period 2000 through 2004 for the incorporated cities in the Southeast Missouri Region. Over the time span displayed, the cities that have exhibited the most growth have been Park Hills, Farmington, Bonne Terre, and Jackson. As can be seen, three of the four fastest growing cities are located in St. Francois County. Bonne Terre exhibited the most dramatic growth between 2000 and 2004 of 59.2% and 36.1% between July 1, 2003 and July 1, 2004. It should be pointed out that the City of Bonne Terre's estimates include the inmate population at the Eastern Reception, Diagnostic and Correctional Center.

In the period April 2000 through July 2004, nine cities have steadily declined in population. The cities of Annapolis, Arcadia, Des Arc, Glen Allen, Ironton, Pilot Knob, Ste. Genevieve, Sedgewickville, and Viburnum have all declined in population since 2000. It should be noted that six of these cities are located in Iron County. Between July 1, 2003 and July 1, 2004 the cities of Arcadia, Ironton, Pilot Knob and Ste. Genevieve continued to exhibit a decline in population. Other cities in the Region have suffered declines in their population but they have not seen the consistent decline that the above cities have shown.
