#### **DRAFT STATE FISCAL YEAR 2013 INTENDED USE PLAN, DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING LOAN FUND PROGRAM AND SET-ASIDE PROGRAMS**

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources is seeking comments on the draft State Fiscal Year 2013 Intended Use Plan (IUP), Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Fund (DWSRF) Loan Program and Set-Aside Programs. The plan is available at <http://www.dnr.mo.gov/env/wpp/srf/drinkingwater-assistance.htm>. A public meeting to discuss and take comments on the plan is scheduled for June 20, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Gasconade Camp Conference Room of the Lewis and Clark State Office Building located at 1101 Riverside Drive in Jefferson City.

The IUP describes loan programs administered by the Water Protection Program and identifies applicants that have requested inclusion in those programs.

Applications submitted by the November 15, 2011 deadline were considered in the competitive review and approval process. Projects were assigned to the Fundable or Planning lists based upon their point ranking and population as described in state regulation. Submittal of the required documents and securing appropriate debt instruments secured were placed highest on the funding lists, which are designed to be a dynamic part of the Intended Use Plan, and may move a community's project from one list to another during the fiscal year subject to available funds.

Missouri is required to match the federal funds to operate the DWSRF, with match funds coming from proceeds of the sale of Environmental Improvement and Energy Resources Authority (EIERA) bonds. Of the EIERA bonds sold to generate 100% of the project costs, an appropriate percentage is clearly identified as state match.

The IUP also includes the State Fiscal Year 2014 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) application which must be received by November 15, 2012 for consideration for placement in next year's IUP.
