### MOSWIN Report

FIRSTNET will have a price per unit and per minute in Spring 2017. Mobile radio required antenna must be mounted to the roof for best reception. National Weather Service Paducah now has a MOSWIN radio for emergency notices.

The CERT coordinator provided report on CERT classes, disaster preparedness activities and other activities engaged in September 1, 2015 to August 30, 2016.
