Commissioner Mooney requested the agenda be approved. Commissioner Nelson moved that the agenda be approved. Commissioner Mullins seconded the motion; motion carried.

Following introductions, Commissioner Koeper asked about the priorities. Mr. Shelton stated there was a meeting on November 15, 2017 stating there are additional funds for road & bridge projects and additional funds for multi-modal. He added Counties need to meet with the RPC to give them priority projects they would like to see get completed if the additional funding becomes available.

Each County Representative gave their priority project lists and Mr. Christian suggested to take the counties #1, and #2 projects and then prioritize them. Commissioner Nelson made a motion to let the SEMO RPC prioritize the counties #1 projects 1 through 7, and #2 projects 8 through 14. Mr. Buerck seconded the motion, motion carried.
