Chairman Welch called the Solid Waste Management District meeting to order at 12:32 p.m. There was a quorum present.

Chairman Welch asked for approval to approve the agenda. Mr. Ruzicka moved to approve the agenda; Mr. Wengert seconded the motion; the motion carried.

Review and Approval of revised budget was tabled until the next meeting

Mr. Tanz gave the update of grants. Holcim's event is complete, and we have received reimbursement request from them. Cape Girardeau County will be having an event in Spring. United Enterprises got their bins and are working through reimbursement request. Bollinger County Recycling is working on their bathroom currently. Perry County Recycling has their cement poured for their drive through. Ste Genevieve County has requested reimbursement.

United Enterprises requested reimbursement for their R2023-004 grant for shred bins. Reimbursement minus their 15% retainage fee would be \$5,789.78. Chairman Welch asked for a motion to approve reimbursement minus retainage fee to United Enterprises. Commissioner Nelson moved to approve reimbursement; Mr. Wengert seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Holcim requested reimbursement for their R2023-003 grant for HHW collection event. Reimbursement. At the time of the meeting Mr. Tanz had not received all the paperwork from Holcim. There is no retainage fee here due to this being a onetime event. This eliminates the quarter reporting. This approval of reimbursement would be contingent on receipt of the needed paperwork. Chairman Welch asked for a motion to approve reimbursement to Holcim contingent on receipt of proper paperwork. Mrs. Stuppy moved to approve reimbursement; Commissioner Scaggs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Other Business:

The annual reports have been extended until December 14, 2022 due to the switch in planners.

The next grant call is in process and hoping to go out on or before January.

The next meeting for the Solid Waste Management District will be determined by the RPC Board. As it was agreed to combine Nov/Dec meetings for the holidays.

Commissioner Nelson moved the meeting be adjourned; Mr. Arnzen seconded the motion; motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 12:40 p.m.
