Chairman Welch called the Solid Waste Management District meeting to order at 12:30 p.m. There was a quorum present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Chairman Welch asked for approval to approve the agenda. Commissioner Ruzicka moved to approve the agenda; Commissioner Kemp seconded the motion; the motion carried.

Chairman Welch asked for approval of the minutes of the January 23, 2024, meeting Commissioner Ruzicka moved that the minutes be approved; Commissioner Stuppy seconded the motion; motion carried.

Chairman Welch requested approval of the treasurer's report. Commissioner Kemp moved the treasurer's report be accepted; Ms. Brunke seconded the motion; motion carried.

Ms. Rios gave the update on grants. Ms. Rios did not have much to report other than quarter 2 reports had been submitted.

Iron County Sheltered Workshop R2024-007 has a budget amendment. The total cost of the project will remain the same, this amendment is just revising the budget to match current expenses. Land clearing went from \$18,570.17 to \$9,821.25; Storage containers went from \$8,186.71 to \$4,182.00, Concrete supplies went up from \$2,625.01 to 4,098.7, structural supplies went up from \$2,680.14 to \$6997.50, Electrical supplies went up from \$5,366.74 to \$9,032.23, miles went from \$299.00 to \$0 and the metal building went from \$9,640.59 to \$13237.50. Commissioner Wengert moved to approve the budget amendment as presented; Commissioner Ruzicka seconded this motion; motion carried.

Iron County Sheltered Workshop R2024-007 has requested a ¼ reimbursement in order to purchase concrete supplies to continue project. This would be in the amount of \$13,620.00. Ms. Brunke moved to approve the request for ¼ reimbursement; Commissioner Stuppy seconded this motion; motion carried.

## Other Business:

Ms. Rios gave an update on the St. Louis Jefferson SWMD v. MoDNR case. As of November 15<sup>th,</sup> 2023, FAAs are no longer required for funding. Funds will now be directly distributed to Solid Waste Management Districts in Missouri. There will still be monitoring of projects. As part of this there will be SWMD plans required by every district. Details of what this needs to include are still up in the air as of now.

The next meeting for the Solid Waste Management District will be March 26, 2024.

Commissioner Kemp moved the meeting be adjourned Commissioner Ruzicka seconded the motion; motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 12:40 p.m.
