Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

Ste. Genevieve Modoc River Ferry posts Title VI notices on our agency's website, in public areas of our agency, and on our boat.

Ste. Genevieve Modoc River Ferry operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin the Ste. Genevieve Modoc River Ferry, you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with the Ste. Genevieve Modoc River Ferry>

1. To obtain a Complaint Form from the Ste. Genevieve Modoc River Ferry contact the Ferry at P.O. Box 302, Ste. Genevieve, Missouri 63670.
2. In addition to the complaint process at the Ste. Genevieve Modoc Ferry, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region VII, 901 Locust Street, Suite 404, Kansas City, MO 64106
3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
